

AHCMOM215 – Operate commercial lawnmowers

This training course outlines the skills and knowledge required to safely operate and commercial lawnmowers to mow a lawn surface including preparation of site and equipment requirements, shutdown procedures and routine maintenance.

Candidates will learn how to:

- + determine the condition of the existing grass surface and seek advice for subsequent routine preparations and treatments,
- + prepare site and equipment used for mowing,
- + use lawnmower, equipment, machinery and implements according to manufacturer specifications,
- + operate a commercial mower safely including making adjustments for attached implements and modifying techniques to meet changed conditions,
- + minimise environmental impacts associated with lawnmower operation,
- + implement lawnmower shut down procedures,
- + carry out routine servicing and maintenance and recorded malfunctions, faults or irregular performance,
- + clean and store mower according to workplace guidelines,
- + follow workplace health and safety procedures for safe use and operation of commercial lawnmowers.

To achieve competency, the candidate is required to successfully complete a theory and practical assessment and demonstrate sufficient performance and knowledge evidence. Participants should have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instructions.
