

Elevated Work Platform (EWP) + Spotter (High Risk Work Licence Course)

TLILIC0005 - Licence to operate a boom-type elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more)

RIIRTM203E - Work as a safety observer/spotter

RIIHAN301E - Operate elevating work platform

This training program teaches candidates the skills and knowledge required to safely operate a boom-type Elevating Work Platform (EWP) where the length of the boom is 11 metres or more in accordance with legislation.

In this course, a boom-type elevating work platform is defined as a telescoping device, hinged device, articulated device, or any combination of these that is used to support a platform that elevates personnel, equipment, or materials.

Candidates will learn how to:

- + Identifying workplace hazards and control measures
- + Selecting appropriate EWP according to workplace conditions and tasks
- Developing effective communication skills
- + Using safety equipment correctly
- + Interpreting signs and labels
- + Confirming sign visibility
- Conducting pre-start operational and visibility checks
- Correctly setting up EWP
- + Assessing safe limits to comply with EWP data plate specifications
- + Managing hazards and stabilising EWP
- + Responding to incidents and unsafe conditions
- Directing and managing vehicle and pedestrian traffic
- + Communicating using hand signals and radios
- + Implementing no-go and exclusion zones
- + Preventing unauthorised access and parking EWP appropriately
- + Following EWP shut down procedures
- + Conducting checks after EWP operation

Candidates are required to successfully complete a theory and practical component to obtain a Statement of Attainment. Participants should have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instructions.
