

FWPCOT2266 - Operate a brushcutter

This training course outlines the skills and knowledge required to safely cut vegetation using a professional standard blade-type brush cutter.

Candidates will learn how to:

Prepare for brush cutting by

- Identifying hazards and implementing controls
- + Completing pre-start brush cutter checks
- Developing effective communication skills
- Identifying vegetation types and appropriate cutting methods

Operate brush cutter by

- Learning how to operate the brush cutter safely
- Adjusting cutting methods to suit site conditions
- + Monitoring personnel movements and debris

Conduct maintenance by

- Learning how to clean brush cutter of debris
- + Inspecting brush cutters for damage and working condition
- + Learning how to remove, adjust, or replace blades as per manufacturer recommendations
- + Completing written records and reports

Candidates are required to successfully complete a theory and practical component to obtain a Statement of Attainment. Participants should have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instructions.
