

RIIMPO317F - Conduct roller operations

This assessment will outline the participant's skills and knowledge required to conduct roller operations. This unit is appropriate for those working in operational roles.

Within this course candidates will be assessed on how to:

- + locate and apply relevant documentation, policies and procedures
- + implement the requirements, procedures and techniques for the safe, effective and efficient completion of roller operations including:
 - conducting prestart checks and shutdown procedures (identifying common faults)
 - driving and operating the equipment to site conditions
 - applying safe work practices and identifying and reporting all potential hazards, risks and environmental issues
 - applying operating techniques for levelling and compacting
 - working safely around other machines and personnel
- + work and communicate effectively with others to undertake and complete roller operations
- + demonstrate completion of roller operations that is safe, effective and efficient including:
 - completion of operations using a variety of different material types
 - compacting materials to pattern and density
 - sealing and finishing
 - adjusting attachments to complete job requirements
 - understanding processes to prepare roller for relocation
 - parking and securing equipment
- + Conduct housekeeping activities at the end of shift

To achieve competency the candidate is required to successfully complete a practical assessment and demonstrating sufficient performance and knowledge evidence.

Assessment will occur in workplace operational situations or, where this is not available, in simulated workplace operational situations that replicate workplace conditions.

This unit alone does not provide sufficient skill to independently load and unload equipment. To perform this activity safely, personnel must either complete or be assisting someone who has completed **RIIHAN308F -Load and unload plant or equivalent**.
