

RIIMPO318F - Conduct civil construction skid steer loader operations

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to operate a skid steer loader to load, haul and distribute materials.

This unit alone does not provide sufficient skill to independently load and unload equipment. To perform this activity safely, personnel must either complete or be assisting someone who has completed **RIIHAN308F - Load and unload plant or equivalent**.

The candidate must demonstrate completion of skid steer loader which includes:

- + Conducting prestart checks prior to commencing operations and shutdown procedures on completion of operations
- + Drive and operating skid steer loader smoothly, and adjusting techniques to suit site conditions
- + Performing skid steer loading tasks
- + Selecting, fitting, testing, using and removing a minimum of one attachment
- + Assisting with loading and unloading skid steer loader from float/trailer
- + Parking and securing equipment

In the course of the above work the candidate must also:

- + Locate and apply relevant documentation, policies and procedures
- + Select and wear personal protective equipment
- + Apply safe work practices
- + Conduct equipment positioning, monitor and manage equipment performance
- + Identify common equipment faults
- + Use a range of communication techniques and equipment

To achieve competency, the candidate is required to successfully complete a practical assessment and demonstrating sufficient performance and knowledge evidence.

Assessment will occur in workplace operational situations or, where this is not available, in simulated workplace operational situations that replicate workplace conditions.
