

RIIWHS204E - Work safely at heights

This training program teaches candidates the skills and knowledge required to work safely at heights, in accordance with legislation.

Candidates will learn how to:

Clean and maintain a safe environment by,

- Consulting with authorised personnel to safely dismantle and remove equipment and materials
- Cleaning, checking, maintaining, and storing tools and equipment

Perform work at heights safely by,

- Check access paths are clear and safe
- Securing fall equipment and adjusting as required
- Monitoring effectiveness of risk and control measures

Identify work procedures and instructions by,

- Implementing fall protection policies
- Using safe manual handling techniques when working with materials and equipment at heights
- Selecting and installing signs and barricades

Identify work requirements by,

- Completing inspections of conditions, structures, weather, site layouts, and equipment
- Identifying, managing, and reporting hazards
- Checking equipment is in good working order

This course is conducted in line with Safe Work Australia Code of Practice 'Managing the Risk Of Falls at Workplaces' OCTOBER 2018.

Candidates are required to successfully complete a theory and a practical component to obtain a Statement of Attainment. Participants should have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instructions.
