Comprising of:

AHCSAW304 - Implement erosion and sediment control measures +
AHCWRK211 - Participate in environmentally sustainable work practices.

This training course outlines the skills and knowledge required to control erosion and sediment using earthworks construction and other land forming activities and effectively measure current resource use and carry out improvements, including reducing the negative environmental impact of work practices. This course applies to individuals who work under broad direction and take responsibility for their own work, including limited responsibility for the work of others.

Within this course, candidates will learn how to:

- + Align work site practices with erosion and sediment control principles by
 - o Understanding erosion and sedimentation legislation and organisation and industry procedures
 - o Noting and reporting breaches of erosion and sediment control legislation
- + Identify current resource use by
 - o Identifying and reporting workplace environmental hazards
 - o Identifying workplace environmental and resource efficiency issues
 - o Seeking opportunities to improve resource efficiency
- + Implement erosion and sediment control plans by
 - o construct, install and maintain a range of erosion and sediment control measures
 - o identify hazards and implement safe work procedures
 - o prepare for implementation and construction
 - o read and follow plans to carry out implementation and construction
 - o identify survey pegs and site indicators on site and on the plans
 - o carry out repairs and maintenance procedures to enterprise standards
 - o select equipment and materials appropriate for the task

To achieve competency, the candidate is required to successfully complete a theory and practical assessment and demonstrate sufficient performance and knowledge evidence. Participants should have sufficient numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instructions.

Assessment will occur in workplace operational situations or, where this is not available, in simulated workplace operational situations that replicate workplace conditions.
