This Code of Conduct applies to all members of the association. Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action or expulsion from the association.

4. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under the age of 18 or anyone in the wider motorcycling community, as your words and actions serve as examples and reflect on the association and all members, sponsors, and Ducati Motor Holdings S.p.A;
5. Be aware of and maintain an uncompromising adherence to The QDMC Inc Constitution, Bylaws, and policies;
6. Do not use your involvement with QDMC Inc to promote your own beliefs (political, religious, or other), behaviours, or practices especially when they are inconsistent with QDMC Inc or Ducati Motor Holdings S.p.A;
7. Understand your responsibility if you breach, or are aware of any breaches, of this Code of Conduct;
8. Understand their repercussions if you breach, or are aware of any breaches, of this Code of Conduct;
9. Refrain from any form of abuse, harassment, or discrimination, towards others;
10. Provide a safe and welcoming environment for all members of the association.
11. Be a positive role model for the association and Ducati at all times.
